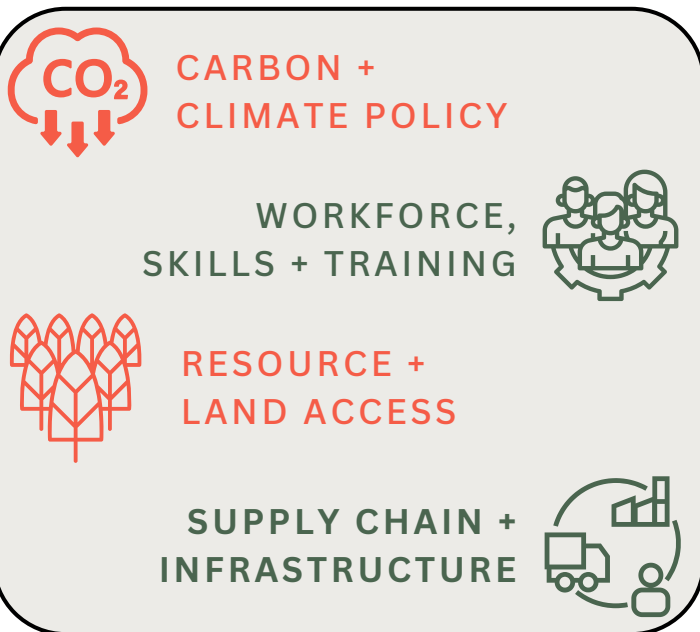


TASMANIA FORESTRY HUB UPDATE

The Hub's remit is to provide information to the Commonwealth on opportunities and barriers for industry growth through stakeholder engagement and consultation.

This year, the Hub will continue stakeholder engagement which will include facilitated workshops with stakeholders.

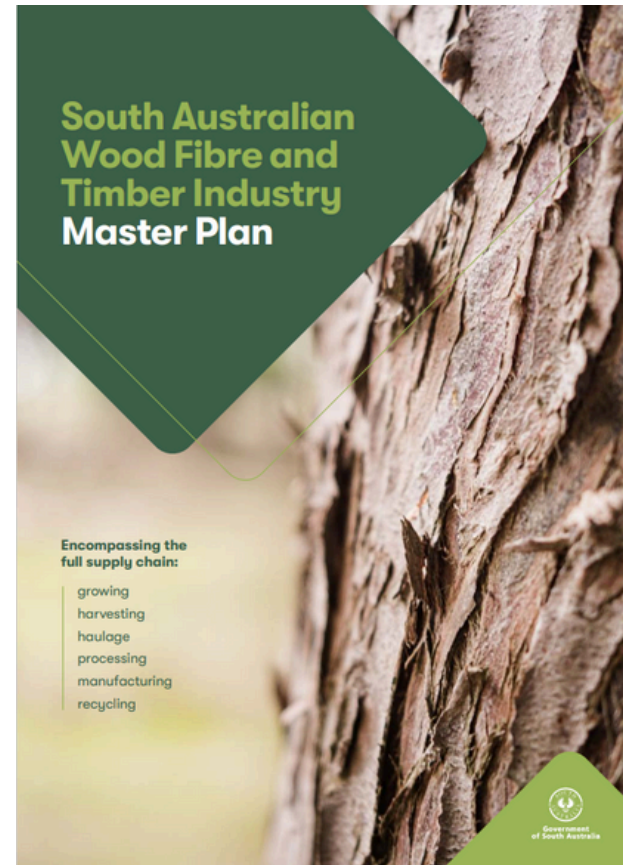
A MASTERPLAN FOR SOUTH AUSTRALIA RELEASED
