BRINGING STAKEHOLDERS TOGETHER - CARBON WORKSHOP

With one of the strategic priorities being Carbon, the Hub has partnered with the Tasmanian Policy Exchange at The University of Tasmania on a project examining the challenges and opportunities for forestry carbon sequestration.

This week, a facilitated workshop with 30 stakeholders focused on the key questions of:

- What are barriers and opportunities to forestry carbon project delivery in Tasmania?
- What improvements could be made to policy and regulator frameworks to support participation in Tasmania?
- How can we ensure that forest carbon projects are sustainable and contribute to meeting future timber demand?
- What could the Tasmanian forest carbon market look like in five years?
